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MCJROTC Grading Policy

1. Four (4) weekly grades.

- a. Weekly Uniform Inspection grade (25%).
- b. Weekly Academic or drill grade (25%).
- c. Physical Training (PT) grade (25%).
- d. Weekly Leadership grade (25%).

2. Uniform Inspection (25%).

- a. Mandatory Uniform inspection on Monday.
- b. Uniform must be worn during the entire school day.
- c. Uniform must be worn properly and all grooming standards met.
- d. Minimum requirement to be in the program.
- e. Zero (0) grade if uniform not worn.
- f. Strong Potential for 100% grade.
- g. Study I.G. Inspection Study Guide to prepare for inspection knowledge.
- h. Written note from parent or guardian in order to be excused.

3. Academic Class (25%).

- a. School grading policy.
- b. Academic participation grade given if a graded requirement is not assigned.

4. Physical Training (PT) (25%).

- a. Mandatory weekly PT.
- b. Zero (0) grade if PT uniform not worn.
- c. PT uniform is issued.
- d. Emphasis on proper wearing of the PT Uniform/proper grooming standards, effort, participation, and teamwork.
- e. Follow PT Rubric.
- f. Potential for 100%
- g. Written note from parent or guardian in order to be excused.

5. Leadership (25%)

- a. 1st year cadet's emphasis on personal conduct and behavior in class, in school, out of school. Follow the MCJROTC Code of Conduct.
- b. 2nd, 3rd, 4th year cadet's emphasis is on personal conduct/behavior, setting the example, contributing to the unit, and leading others.

c. Follow Leadership Rubric.

d. Average should be 85%.

Recipe for Success:

1. Wear uniform for every uniform inspection.

2. Wear PT uniform for every PT session.

3. Maintain good personal conduct and behavior at all times.
